

**14TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT
COMMUNITY SERVICE RULES**

All community service work must be approved by the Court or its designee for credit to be received.

To receive credit for community service, the Community Service Work Log and 14th Judicial District Supervising Affidavit must be submitted together.

Incomplete or inaccurate forms will result in community service credit not being awarded.

Community service work will be credit at the rate of \$ 5.00 per hour against fines and fees you owe the Court.

Community service work cannot be credited against restitution, fingerprint fee, KBI lab fee, KBI DNA fees or BIDS application fee.

Request for community service credit must be received within 14 days of service being performed / completed or credit will not be granted.

A form must be submitted for each place an individual performance community service.

Community service work must occur within the 14th Judicial District (Montgomery or Chautauqua counties).
